

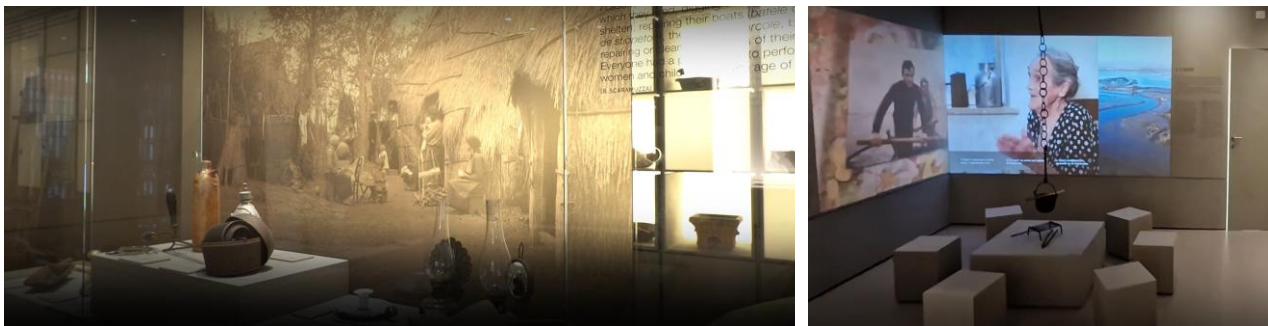

Introduction to the Grado Lagoon

Learn about the traditional fishermen's huts (*casoni*) and the seasonal way of life that developed around fishing, navigation and resource management.

Discover the techniques, tools and knowledge used by generations of lagoon fishermen and how these practices shaped the cultural identity of Grado.

The Human Story of the Lagoon

Explore the relationship between people and water, and how lagoon communities adapted to an environment characterised by tides, islands and seasonal cycles.
